Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to 18 CFR 16.8(d), Eagle Creek Schoolfield, LLC (Eagle Creek Schoolfield), a subsidiary of Eagle Creek Renewable Energy, and the City of Danville, Virginia, (collectively, “co-Licensees”) are hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) their Final Application for License for Major Project – Existing Dam (Application) for the Schoolfield Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 2411, Project) located on the Dan River in the City of Danville, Virginia.

Concurrent with this filing, the co-Licensees are notifying the entities listed on the attached Distribution List that the Application is being filed and can be downloaded from the FERC eLibrary site (<https://elibrary.ferc.gov/>).
