



INITIAL STATEMENT PER 18 CFR § 4.61(b)

Application for New License – Major Water Power Project 10 Megawatts or Less

- (1) Eagle Creek Schoolfield, LLC (Eagle Creek Schoolfield), an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Eagle Creek Renewable Energy, LLC (Eagle Creek), and the City of Danville (City), collectively the Applicant, apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission or FERC) for a new license for the existing Schoolfield Hydroelectric Project (Project), FERC No. 2411, as described in the attached Exhibits hereafter. The current license for the Schoolfield Hydroelectric Project was issued on August 26, 1994 and expires on July 31, 2024.
- (2) The location of the Project is:

- (5) The Applicant is a domestic corporation (Eagle Creek Schoolfield, LLC) and municipality (City of Danville). The Applicant is not claiming preference under section 7(a) of the Federal Power Act, 16 USC 800.
- (6) Regulatory requirements:
 - (i) The statutory or regulatory requirements of the Commonwealth of Virginia that affect the Project as it exists with respect to bed and banks and the appropriation, diversion, and use of water for power purposes, and with respect to the right to engage in the business of developing, transmitting, and distributing power and in any other business necessary to accomplish the purpose of the license under the Federal Power Act, are:
 - Water Quality Certification from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality under §401(a)(1) of the Clean Water Act.
 - The City of Danville's municipal charter because the Applicant (co-Licensee City of Danville) is a municipality. A copy of the City of Danville's municipal charter is provided after the Verification Statement.
 - (ii) The steps which the applicant has taken or plans to take to comply with the regulations cited above are:
 - The Applicant will submit a request for Water Quality Certification from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality at the time when the Commission issues its Ready for Environmental Analysis notice as permitted and pursuant to 18 CFR §4.34(b)(5)(i).

- (9) The Project is an existing, operating project. The Project dam and powerhouse was constructed and completed from 1902 into 1904. The original generating equipment was replaced in 1990 and 1991. No major Project modifications are proposed.

Eagle Creek Schoolfield, LLC and the City of Danville currently own and will continue to maintain all proprietary rights necessary to construct, operate, and maintain the Project.

The Schoolfield Hydroelectric Project is located in the City of Danville, Virginia, and is not adjacent to the boundary of any other city, town, or similar political subdivision, and does not use any Federal facilities and occupies no Federal lands.

ii. That has a population of 5,000 or more people and is located within 15 miles of the Project dam.

(iii) Every irrigation district, drainage district, or similar special purpose political subdivision (A) in which any part of the Project is located, and any Federal facility that is or is proposed to be used by the Project is located, or (B) that owns, operates, maintains, or uses any Project facility or any Federal facility that is or is proposed to be used by the Project:

Water of the Project reservoir serves as the City of Danville's municipal water supply. The water supply intake is located approximately 440 feet upstream of the

Project powerhouse. Currently, the City of Danville typically withdraws, on average, 8.0 million gallons per day (mgd) from the Project reservoir and is authorized to withdraw up to 18 mgd. There are no other irrigation districts, drainage districts, or similar special purpose political subdivisions in which any part of the Project is located or that owns, operates, maintains, or uses any Project facility. The Project uses no Federal facilities and occupies no Federal lands.

(iv) Every other political subdivision in the general area of the Project that there is reason to believe would likely be interested in, or affected by, the application.

Eagle Creek Schoolfield, LLC and the City of Danville are not aware of other political subdivisions in the general area of the Project.

(3) Notification:

Since this is an application for a new license for an existing Project under Section 15 of the FPA, the requirement to provide notification by certified mail of the filing of the application does not apply.

The Applicant intends to exercise its rights under Section 210(e) of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA). The Project is not located at a new dam or diversion. The applicant reserves the right to exercise any additional rights available to it under PURPA in the future.
