On August 31, 2018 Lakeport Hydroelectric One, LLC (“Lakeport”), filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) its Pre-Application Document, Notice of Intent, and Request to Use the Traditional Licensing Process (TLP) for the relicensing of its Lakeport Hydroelectric Project (“Project”, FERC No. 6440). The Commission, by letter order dated October 30, 2018, granted Lakeport’s request to use the TLP.

- Review of Information Provided in the PAD
- Solicit Comments and Information/Study Requests

Lakeport submitted a public notice of the Joint Meeting and Site Visit for publication in the Laconia Daily Sun, a daily published newspaper that serves Belknap County, NH, where the Project is located. The notice is scheduled to run in the December 5, 2018 edition of the newspaper.
