On September 30, 2025, Kezar Falls Hydro, LLC (“KFH”), filed the Pre-Application Document (PAD) for the Kezar Falls Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 9340) (Project) with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission). The Project is located on the Ossipee River in York and Oxford Counties, Maine. On December 4, 2025, the Commission approved KFH’s request to use the Traditional Licensing Process (TLP) for relicensing the Project.

KFH held a Joint Agency and Public Meeting (Joint Meeting) regarding the Project, followed by a site visit on January 23, 2026.

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 16.8(b)(4), KHF hereby files a copy of the audio recording of the Joint Meeting (Attachment A1, A2, and A3) and the slide presentation provided at the Joint Meeting (Attachment B). A sign-in sheet identifying Joint Meeting participants is included as well (Attachment C). 


Water Resources



- No ground disturbing activities are planned.






