Subject: Draft Application for Subsequent License for the Rockton Hydroelectric Project

(FERC No. 2373) and New License for the Dixon Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2466)

# Dear Secretary Bose:

Midwest Hydro, LLC (Midwest Hydro, Licensee, or Applicant), an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Eagle Creek Renewable Energy, LLC is the owner and operator of the Rockton Hydroelectric Project (Rockton Project) (FERC No. 2373). STS Hydropower (STS Hydro, Licensee, or Applicant) an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Eagle Creek, is the owner and operator of the Dixon Hydroelectric Project (Dixon Project) (FERC No 2466)<sup>1</sup>. The Rockton Project is located on the Rock River, in the Township of Rockton, Village of Rockton, and City of South Beloit in Winnebago County, Illinois. The Dixon Project is located on the Rock River in the Township of Dixon and City of Dixon in Lee County, Illinois. The current licenses expire on August 31, 2024.

In accordance with 18 CFR 4.32 (h), Midwest Hydro and STS Hydropower are hereby filing the Draft License Application for the relicensing of the Rockton and Dixon Hydroelectric Projects.<sup>2</sup> The Licensee has prepared this DLA to conform to the requirements of the Commission's regulations at 18 CFR §§ 4.38, 4.61, and 16.10 as required under the Traditional Licensing Process (TLP) that was approved by the Commission on October 16, 2019. Pursuant to 18 CFR § 4.38 and by copy of this letter (via email and/or US mail), the Licensee is providing a link to the Project's relicensing website at <a href="https://www.eaglecreekre.com/facilities/operating-facilities/rock-river-hydro-facilities/rock-river-relicensing-information">https://www.eaglecreekre.com/facilities/operating-facilities/rock-river-hydro-facilities/rock-river-relicensing-information</a>. From this website, an electronic copy of the public portions of the DLA may be downloaded for review by relevant resource agencies, tribes, non-governmental organizations, and other potential interested parties included in the attached distribution list. Written comments are due within 90 days of the date of this filing. Should stakeholders experience difficulty downloading the document or

   As such, the Licensee has filed the CEII Version of Volume 2 with the Commission designated as CEII.
- Appendices E-16 and E-17 included in Volume 3 contain privileged archaeological site locational information. As such Midwest Hydro and STS Hydropower has filed Appendices E-16 and E-17 separately and designated the information as privileged.
